I decided to write a mini-grant through <u>DonorsChoose.org</u>. Donors<u>Choose.org</u> is a non-profit organization where public school teachers can create projects of resources that are needed within their classroom that people, organizations, or business have the opportunity to donate money towards.

My most recent mini-grant project that I submitted was entitled "We See Our Future- It's Technology Shaped." Within this grant, I asked for technology resources that could be implemented into my classroom for daily instruction. With the amount of points given, I was able to create a project that was up to \$2000. With this amount of money, I was able to ask for 6 iPad minis, 1 tablet, and cases.


